(Isaiah 9:6, KJB – to see that the “mighty God” of line 6 is Jehovah and the same as the “Almighty God,” compare Psa.50:1; Isa.10:20-21; Jer.32:18; Rev.1:8)

Note that the promised Messiah is to be a human son that will be born (line 1) and that he is also the “mighty God” (line 6) as well as being the “everlasting Father” (line 7). John 4:24 explains this when it says: “God is a Spirit” – not 3 different Gods. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are all one and the same eternal, everlasting Spirit.
