12. Azariah (Uzziah, 1 Chr. 6:24)
13. Joel (Shaul, 1 Chr. 6:24)
14. Elkanah¹

18. Zuph (Zophai, 1 Chr. 6:26)
19. Toah (Nahath, 1 Chr. 6:26; Tohu, 1 Sam. 1:1)
20. Eliel (Eliab, 1 Chr. 6:27; Elihu, 1 Sam. 1:1)
21. Jeroham
22. lkanah³ (1 Sam. 1:1, Hannah's husband)
23. Samuel (a levite but not of Aaron, so not a priest: cp. 4-6 above; yet 1 Sam. 7:9-10)
24. Joel (Vashni, 1 Chr. 6:28 & 33; cp. 1 Sam. 8:2–3, a wicked son)
25. Heman (c.1047 BC, 1 Chr. 6:31b – whom David set over the singers: 1 Chr. 15:17 & 19, 16:41–42, 25:1 & 4–6)

Samuel almost certainly prophesied in song at 1 Samuel 19:18–25. cp. 10:5–6
